REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

There are 3 ways to order your repeat prescriptions: -

1 – Telephone the Medicines Order Line (MOL) on 01158 550 260, or visit www.derbyshiremol.nhs.uk and complete an online form

2- Sign up for Patient Online Access and order them online via our practice website

3 – NHS App

We do not accept requests for medication over the telephone or in person at the surgery.

When you are due for a medication review you will be asked to book an appointment with the practice pharmacist before you order your next prescription. This may involve having a blood test prior to the appointment.

NHS HEALTH CHECKS

The NHS Health Check is a check-up for adults in England aged 40 to 74 who do not have a pre-existing health condition. It can help spot early signs of stroke, kidney disease, diabetes or heart disease. The NHS Health Check involves a blood test, ECG, measurements such as height, weight & blood pressure, and questions about your lifestyle i.e. alcohol intake, smoking status, and questions about your family health history.
